Claim Network ID

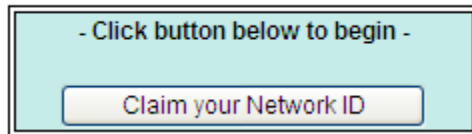
Once accepted to SIUC, you will need to claim your Network ID and assign yourself a password in order to access SalukiNet. You will need to have your Dawg Tag # handy in order to complete this process.

Please follow the instructions to claim your Network ID:

1. Go to: <https://netid.siu.edu/>
2. Scroll down until you see the image below and click on it:



3. Fill in your information and follow the remainder of the account claim process.

Once you have completed the claim process, a dialog box will appear. The box will contain your Network ID number. Please make sure you keep this information as you will need it to register for classes. In case you lose your information, your Network ID is: SIU + your dawg tag number (ex: siu85*****).

Badge and Pass Information for EST & HCM

EST and HCM students who are non-military will need a pass to get on base each semester. Listed below are the documents you will need to gain access to the base:

1. Valid Driver's License
2. Vehicle Registration
3. Proof of Insurance

If you are not listed on the registration of the vehicle you will be driving, you will need to have a letter from the person listed on the registration giving you permission to drive the vehicle on base.

Badge and Pass Revised Hours of Operation

Effective 1 October 2009

M-F 0600-1600 (6am - 4pm)

Sat/Sun 0800-1100 (8am - 11am)

Individuals who require assistance outside the prescribed hours of operation will be able to receive a one day pass at the Main Gate if they have a valid requirement to enter the installation, current proof of registration, insurance and a valid driver's license.
