Cashiering & Sales	Includes sales clerks, check cashing, ticket sales, cashiers and telemarketing.		
Outside Commission Sales		Applicable only to student employees in the School of Journalism.	
Classroom Assistant	Includes tutors, proctors and notetakers.

Event Staff	Includes set up/take down lights and staging, duties during event, greeting/ushering patrons to their seats, staffing concessions, and loading/unloading trucks.
