

PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
VINCENNES UNIVERSITY
VINCENNES, INDIANA
AND
SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY AT CARBONDALE
CARBONDALE, ILLINOIS

In an effort to provide a continued, articulated computer systems technologies baccalaureate degree program that will build on lower division level and upper division level learning experiences, this agreement is set forth between Vincennes University and the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University on behalf of Southern Illinois University at Carbondale (SIUC).

1. All graduates of Vincennes University with a major in Computer Programming Technology will receive preferential admission status into SIUC's Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Information Systems Technologies (IST) program in the College of Applied Sciences and Arts upon application to SIUC.
2. A Vincennes University graduate receiving an A.S. Degree in Computer Programming Technology and earning an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.25 on a 4.0 scale as calculated by the University's grading regulations at the time of receiving the degree, and choosing a transferable math and social science elective is eligible for the Capstone Option for admission to SIUC's IST program. This guarantees the A.S. degree recipient in Computer Programming Technology that the IST degree can be completed with a total of no more than 60 semester hours of work at SIUC. Vincennes University students must complete the SIUC Capstone Application (separate from the admissions application) to be admitted under this option.
3. Those Vincennes University graduates receiving an A.S. degree in Computer Programming Technology with less than an overall 2.25 GPA, but with an overall GPA of 2.0 to 2.24 and choosing a transferable math and social science elective, will be eligible for preferential admission to IST. However, such students will be required to take not more than 82 semester hours of work at SIUC, including a combination of IST major coursework and university core curriculum requirements.
4. An SIUC IST representative will meet not less than once a year with Vincennes University students planning to articulate to SIUC under this agreement for general advisement and degree planning purposes.
5. Upon successful completion of all degree requirements, and following all policies and regulations stated in the program and university guidelines, Vincennes University students will be eligible to receive the Bachelor of Science degree in Information Systems Technologies, College of Applied Sciences and Arts, Southern Illinois University at Carbondale.
6. Should changes occur in course or program content, the school making the change agrees to notify the other school in writing so that this agreement can be re-evaluated. Notice of changes shall be given at least 45 days prior to the beginning of the semester

when the change is implemented.
